

SAVE THE DATES FOR OUR NEW TRANSFORMATION PROGRAM

Pathwork Vermont is re-structuring its residential, yearlong Transformation and Helpership programs so we become more accessible to out-of-state seekers. We are moving away from a seven-weekend structure to a 4 x 4 model, implemented with online teaching. A 4X4 format means that participants meet 4 times per year for 4 days. In addition to meeting four times per year in a residential setting, PTP students connect online, in 3-hour blocks, three times per year for additional teaching and practice.

Description of Pathwork Vermont newly designed Transformation Program.

Our Transformation Program is based on the Guide's lectures, as well as Moira Shaw's 50/50 teachings. It is where the journey of self-inquiry begins.

It is a powerful and expansive discipline of psychological and spiritual development, which recognizes the existence of several levels of consciousness and the necessity of progressing through all the levels to awaken to the Unified Consciousness, which dwells within all sentient beings.

It is designed for mature individuals, who have completed some therapy or spiritual work and are in search of a practical spiritual path, which offers opportunities for deep transformation in a community setting.

It offers an in-depth exploration of the Lectures and through their teachings facilitates personal and spiritual growth through the development of a healthy, mature ego.

On one hand, students are guided to explore conceptually, experientially and energetically our basic misunderstandings about life and self, in the world of duality. They are encouraged to acknowledge and accept the fragmented parts of the self that exist in isolation, immaturity and destructiveness and bring them into a healthier state of maturity and positivity.

On the other hand, students are invited to consider the possibilities we have, as human beings to live as spiritual beings on earth; they learn what it takes to move one's self identification from a weak ego self, to a more mature ego self, and ultimately to the spiritual Self.
